TOURNAMENT ORGANISATION

ARTICLE 1 :

THE 8 TEAMS ARE ORGANIZED IN 2 GROUPS OF 4 TEAMS. EACH TEAM PLAYS AGAINST THE OTHER THREE IN THE GROUP.

ARTICLE 2 :

- GROUP MATCHES ARE PLAYED IN 4 QUARTERS OF 7 MINUTES EACH, INTERRUPTIONS BEING DEDUCTED. THERE IS A 2-MINUTE BREAK BETWEEN QUARTERS AND A 5-MINUTE BREAK AT HALF-TIME.

- ONE TIMEOUT IN 1ST HALF AND TWO TIMEOUTS IN 2ND HALF FOR EACH TEAM.

- A PLAYER IS OUT AFTER 5 FOULS.

IN CASE OF A DRAW AT THE END OF FULL TIME : A 4-MINUTE EXTRA TIME. IF TEAMS ARE AGAIN LEVEL, THERE WILL BE 5 FREE THROWS BY EACH TEAM WITH THE PLAYERS ON THE COURT AT THE END OF THE MATCH.

THE FINAL FOR 7TH, 5TH AND 3TH PLACES AND THE FINAL WILL BE PLAYED IN 4 X 10 MN EACH INTERRUPTIONS BEING DEDUCTED.

ARTICLE 3 :

- TEAMS FINISHING 1TH IN EACH GROUP WILL PLAY THE FINAL,

- TEAMS FINISHING 2TH IN EACH GROUP WILL PLAY CLASSIFYING MATCH FOR 3RD PLACE 5TH PLACE.

- TEAMS FINISHING 3TH IN EACH GROUP WILL PLAY CLASSIFYING MATCH FOR 5TH PLACE.

- TEAMS FINISHING 4TH IN EACH GROUP WILL PLAY CLASSIFYING MATCH FOR 7TH PLACE.

ARTICLE 3 BIS :

IF SOME TEAMS ARE LEVEL AT THE END OF GROUPS MATCHES:

- IF 2 TEAMS ARE LEVEL, THE WINNING TEAM OF THE GROUP MATCH WILL COME BEFORE THE LOSING TEAM;

- IF 3 TEAMS ARE LEVEL, THE AVERAGE BASKET BETWEEN THE 3 TEAMS WILL DETERMINE THE ORDER.

ARTICLE 4 :

TEAMS HAVE A 15-MINUTE WARM-UP PERIOD AS SOON AS THE PREVIOUS MATCH IS OVER. THE SCORE TABLE TRIGGERS THE STOPWATCH.

ARTICLE 5 :

ANY DISPUTE SHALL BE SETTLED BY A COMMITTEE OF 3 MEMBERS (2 FROM THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE AND THE REFEREES' SUPERVISOR).

ARTICLE 6 :

MATCHES WILL BE HELD BY OFFICIAL REFEREES CHOSEN BY A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE REGIONAL LEAGUE BASKETBALL AND SCORE TABLE OFFICIALS CHOSEN BY REPRESENTATIVES OF THE REGIONAL LEAGUE.

GENERAL ORGANIZATION

ARTICLE 1 :

IN THE EVENT OF A DISPUTE OVER THE RULES ENFORCEMENT (AND NOT THE GAME ITSELF), THE 3-MEMBER ORGANIZATION COMMITTEE, MM. JEAN-PAUL BOYRON, FRÉDÉRIC FAIVRE AND JÉRÔME DUFFOUX WILL SETTLE THE DISPUTE.

ARTICLE 2 :

EACH TEAM MUST HAVE 2 SETS OF SHORTS AND JERSEYS OF DIFFERENT COLOURS.

ARTICLE 3 :

EACH DELEGATION WILL HAVE THE NECESSARY INSURANCE DOCUMENTS COVERING HOSPITAL AND MEDICAL COSTS IN CASE OF AN ACCIDENT, PLAYERS', COACHES' AND CHAPERONS' LIABILITY INSURANCE.

ASVR BASKET DECLINES ALL RESPONSIBILITY IN THIS RESPECT.

EACH PLAYER AND COACH TAKING PART IN THE TOURNAMENT WILL HAVE A VALID LICENSE FROM HIS FEDERATION FOR THE 2025/26 SEASON.

ARTICLE 4 :

PLAYERS AND COACHES WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE FACILITIES CLEAN, PARTICULARLY CHANGING ROOMS. IN CASE OF BREACH OF THE RULES, THE TOURNAMENT ORGANIZERS WILL BE ABLE TO TAKE ALL THE NECESSARY MEASURES, INCLUDING THE EXPULSION OF A TEAM FROM THE TOURNAMENT.

ARTICLE 5 :

PLAYERS AND COACHES MUST BE PRESENT 15 MINUTES BEFORE STARTING WARM-UP.

ARTICLE 6 :

THROUGHOUT THE TOURNAMENT, FROM FRIDAY, (DINNER TIME) UNTIL MONDAY (BREAKFAST), THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE WILL PROVIDE MEALS FOR 12 PLAYERS AND 3 COACHES IN EACH TEAM. SUNDAY EVENING MEALS ARE NOT PROVIDED BY THE ORGANIZATION. ANY OTHER MEAL(S) TAKEN ELSEWHERE WILL BE COVERED BY THE DELEGATION(S) CONCERNED.

ARTICLE 7 :

ON ARRIVAL, THE TOURNAMENT ORGANIZERS WILL GIVE EACH TEAM A FOLDER WITH ALL THE NECESSARY INFORMATION REGARDING THEIR STAY (TOURNAMENT RULES, MEALS ORGANIZATION, ACCOMMODATION SITES).
